

### Winter Crisis Program

November 1 - March 31

The Home Energy Assistance Winter Crisis Program (HEAP Winter Crisis Program) helps income eligible Ohioans that are threatened with disconnection, have been disconnected or have less than a 25% supply of bulk fuel in their tank maintain their utility service. The program can also assist with fuel tank replacement, fuel tank testing and heating system repair.

#### **Eligible Participants**

- Household income at or below 175% of the federal poverty guidelines
- Facing disconnection
- · Have been disconnected
- Have less than a 25% supply of bulk fuel in their tank

#### **Required Documentation**

- Income for primary applicant & all household members 18 years of age or older
- Social Security Numbers for primary applicant & all household members
- Most recent utility bills
- Proof of citizenship for all household members

## FREE PROGRAM THAT OFFERS SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL AND INTELLECTUAL GROWTH TO PREPARE CHILDREN FOR SUCCESS IN LIFE

Head Start is a comprehensive program for children and their families. We offer Home-Based and Center-Based options to best meet your needs. The Home-Based option consist of a home based teacher, child, and family work together to provide activities and experiences designed to meet the child's needs in the home environment for 1.5 hours.

**WHAT SERVICES** ARE PROVIDED? Developmental screenings, hearing, vision, dental exam and treatment, lead testing, hemoglobin testing, parenting classes, and various training opportunities. Transportation to the center may be provided for eligible children and each child receives a free snack, breakfast and/or hot lunch daily. Field trips and family days are scheduled throughout the year.

WHAT ARE THE **REQUIREMENTS?** 

- Families income must be at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Families/children experiencing homelessness or who are in foster care are also eligible.

- Children with a disability may also qualify.
